Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The collection contains booklets from the annual Diocesan Teacher's Institute (1945-1972), which later was called the Wisconsin Catholic Teachers Institute. Primarily advertisements, the booklets contain the agenda of the meeting, which had a unique theme for each year. Also included in later years of the series is directory information (principals and school addresses) of all the Catholic schools in Wisconsin along with educational statistics. For the years 1971-1980, the title is Wisconsin Catholic Teachers Directory.
